

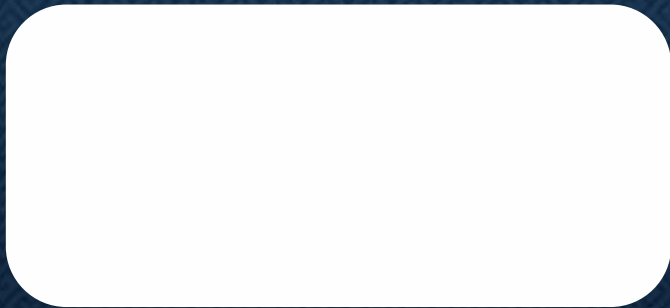
# Passport of Achievement

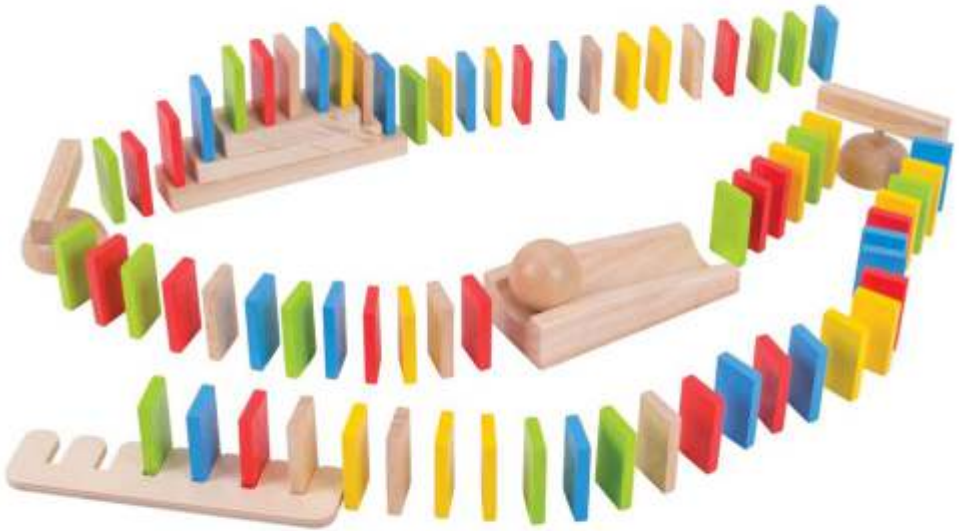
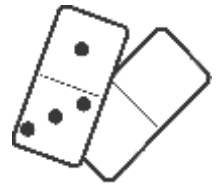

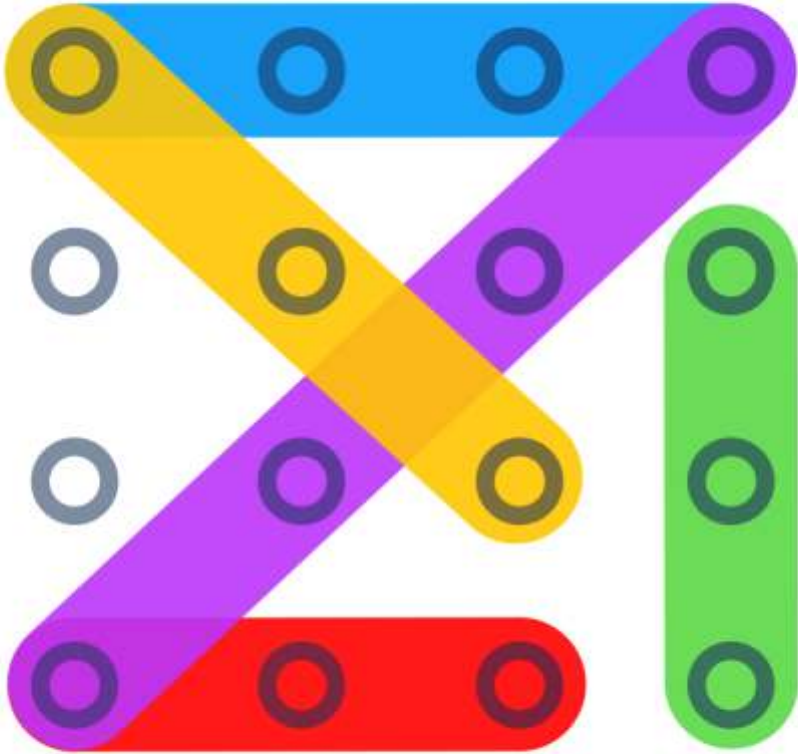
