Dear Parents and Carers



This morning, we received the message below from Public Health:



*'It is important to be aware as we enter the last week of term that COVID rates amongst school-age children in Lincolnshire are higher now than at any time in the pandemic so far. With a relaxation of rules permitted from the 19<sup>th</sup>, it is possible that we will see a further increase in cases associated with these last few days before the summer break. Quite apart from the potential impact on families' holiday plans, this could lead to transmission to more vulnerable members of school communities.'*



In light of this latest information, we will continue with our current risk assessment until the end of term. This means we will continue to maintain bubbles and will continue with our rolling drop off and collection until the summer holiday. When we open again in September, current advice is that we will no longer be required to maintain bubbles and we will no longer require rolling drop offs and collections.



Our normal start times and end times will resume. These are 8:55 (although we open our doors from 8:45) and 3:20 in the main school. For Nursery, our sessions run from 8:45 to 11:45 and 12:30 to 3:30.
