<ul> <li>Green Group</li> <li>Greatest chance of academic success.</li> <li>More opportunities to enhance life skills.</li> <li>Allows children to maximise their potentials.</li> <li>Children could receive Kirts to spend in the shop.</li> <li>Trophies, certificates and unique prizes may be earned.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>No concerns from the school.</li> <li>The child attends between 98% - 100% of the time.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>More knowledge acquired.</li> <li>Improved social skills.</li> <li>Children will be proud.</li> <li>Pupils will feel they have achieved.</li> </ul>

<ul> <li>Red Group</li> <li>Very hard for your child to achieve.</li> <li>Potential fines for parents.</li> <li>Possibility of court proceedings for parents.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Extreme concern from the school about a child's health and / or attendance.</li> <li>Child attends less than 90% of the time.</li> </ul>	<ul> <li>Attendance panel could make contact to complete an Early Help Assessment.</li> <li>Outside agencies may become involved with the family.</li> <li>Targets could be set for attendance.</li> <li>The courts are able to fine parents up to £2500 and can sentence parents to imprisonment for up to three months for their child's non-attendance at school.</li> </ul>
