### Internet Safety/ Weather songs

This week we have learnt a little bit about internet safety. We have talked about what we should do if we see something we do not like while we are using an electronic device. Please take time to consider how your child can safely use electronic devices such as tablets, games consoles and phones that they may have access to. ### Information for Parents/Carers:

Children are naturally curious and want to understand the world they live in, and it is our responsibility to enable them to do so. *Talk about what they see, using a wide vocabulary. (EAD 3-4)*

*Begin to understand the need to respect and care for the natural environment and all living things. (EAD 3-4)*

*Remember and sing entire songs. (EAD 3-4)*
