3 stickers each term will earn your child a Celebration of Achievement certificate!




Sound Walk

This week, we are learning the story 'Rosie's Walk' by Pat Hutchins. This book is about a hen who goes for a walk around a farmyard and hears lots of different sounds because the fox has some problems crashing and falling into things.

This week, it would be lovely if you could go for a walk too. This could be a walk out for fun or even just your usual walk to nursery. We want you to listen to the sounds you can hear on your walk. Please encourage your child to have a go at making the sounds they hear using their voices. For example, they might hear a car - 'brrr', a police car - 'whooh' or a duck 'quack'.

Perhaps you could take some pictures of your child on their walk or make a list of the noises that they heard.



Information for Parents/Carers:

This term, in Big Owls, our topic is 'Holidays and Days Out', so we are going to be learning about different places we can go for days out, including the seaside. This week, we are thinking and learning about going for a walk and noticing the things we can hear. It is really important that we encourage children to tune into sounds, listening to different sounds and making sounds with their voices, to support their phonological awareness. We shall be focussing on phonological awareness over the coming weeks as many of our children prepare for primary school.

What your Child is Learning:

Beginning to explore phonological awareness by tuning in to sounds. To explore voice sounds by playing voice sound games, for example, making their own voices go down a slide - 'Wheeeee!', or moo like a cow - 'Mooo'.
