Dear Parents and Carers

Welcome to summer term. This term will bring lots of new and exciting challenges to your child's learning experience.

Our Topic

Term 5: Intrepid Explorers

Our topic this term is 'Intrepid Explorers'. Throughout this topic, we will be looking at the greatest explorers, and designing and making fabric bunting.

We will also be identifying and naming a variety of plants and trees and describing their structure. The children will also be looking at where our food comes from.

Maths and English

In maths lessons, children will be learning about: place value; addition and subtraction; position and direction; multiplication; division; and measurement of length and height.

In order to support your child, you could practise addition and subtraction problems, play position and direction games, chant the times tables and explore measurements of height and length in your home.

Alongside this, reciting number facts for the 2s, 5s and 10 times tables in various orders will support the development of instant recall.

It would really support your child if they were confident with their times tables. This would help_them in all areas of maths. This term, your child will begin to learn facts for the 2s 10s and 5s times tables.

In English, we will be learning about narratives, information texts, letters, fairy tales, poems and diaries.

In order to support your child, you could write a letter in response to the letter written by your child's class teacher below. Alongside this, you could use the fairytale dice game to write your own fairytale! Roll the di to decide your character, setting and prop!

The spellings your child will be learning this term can be accessed through our school website; it would be really useful if you could help your child to learn these spellings.

Please encourage your child to read at home every day and ask them questions about what they are reading at every opportunity. We aim to change books regularly.

Your child may bring a water bottle to school. Please ensure the bottle is clearly named and only contains water.

This term, our indoor PE days are Mondays for Sparrows, Wednesdays for Wrens and Robins. Our outdoor PE days are Monday for Wrens and Robins, Wednesday for Sparrows. Please ensure that your child has the appropriate PE kit. For outdoor games, the children need plain black/navy tracksuit bottoms, a plain white t-shirt, a plain sweatshirt and trainers. For indoor PE, the children need plain black/navy shorts, a plain white t-shirt and plimsolls. Every item needs to be clearly labelled and in a bag that will remain in school every day. Kits will be taken home to be washed at the end of each term. No items should be taken home during the term.

Homework

Homework is set on a Friday and will continue to support your child's education. It will include weekly spellings and a review of the children's phonics learning from their week in school. If there are ever any problems about the homework, please come to see us as soon as possible.

Warmer weather

As the weather is getting warmer, children may need to bring hats into school. Please ensure that these are clearly named. Sunscreen should be applied at home





before coming to school. We are not able to assist your child in applying this in school.


