Extreme Temperatures 18th and 19th July 2022



Dear Parents and Carers

Kirton falls within the red alert zone for extreme temperatures on Monday and Tuesday.



We know we are likely to struggle to maintain safe temperatures within school.

If you would prefer to keep your child off school on these two days, please email the school on enquiries@parliamentfederation.co.uk, stating your child's full name and their class. Please put 'precautionary absence' in the email title. Remember to state which days your child will be absent (Monday and/or Tuesday). We will authorise your child's absence for the days for which we are informed.



Please note that we will be unable to set remote work as the teachers will be simultaneously teaching in classrooms. We will also be unable to supply a midday meal since these are hot meals and have already been ordered.



Should you only be able to collect your child partway through the day, you must collect them from the office. This will also be authorised. Collection must be by a named contact, unless you email the school in advance to give an alternative adult permission.



We apologise for the late information, but we had been hoping for external advice which has not been forthcoming.



Classroom temperatures will be difficult to maintain with up to 30 children in them. We are also particularly concerned about lunchtimes when the hot meals are served in the hall. Reducing the number of children in the school should make it easier to maintain safe temperatures.



We appreciate that many children will still need to come into school, and we will be open as usual for those children.
